### BIOGRAPHY: Family Information:

Was father to Joel, who served. Daughter, Rebecca (1) died in 1762. His brother, Joseph Jenkins, Jr. also served. He lived at 480 Woburn St. His gravesite is marked with an ornately engraved slate stone in the old section of Wildwood.

At age 50 was a Private in Captain Timothy Walker's Militia Company, Colonel Davis Greene's Regiment which marched on the alarm of 19 April, 1775. Service 2 1/2 days. Joseph marched 30 miles on the 19 April alarm and was paid 6 shillings, 1/4 pence.

Was on the list of men responsible for the turns of service on Crown Point Expedition dated 8 July, 1776. Joseph along with son, Joel credited with 1 turn.

Was also a Private in Captain Jesse Wyman's Company, Col. Josiah Whitney's Regiment. He arrived at his destination on 10 May, 1777. Discharged 10 July, 1777 at Point Judith. Service 2 months, 9 days at Rhode Island including 3 days to travel to place of destination and 5 days to travel home (60 miles) from Point Judith.

Joseph married **Sarah BARRON** on 16 Nov 1749 in Wilmington, Middlesex, MA, USA. Sarah was born on 4 Aug 1725 in Westford, Middlesex, MA, USA. She died on 7 Mar 1810 in Wilmington, Middlesex, MA, USA. She was buried in Mar 1810 in Wildwood Cemetery: Wilmington, Middlesex, MA, USA.

**BIOGRAPHY:** Joel was son of Joseph. He married Captain Timothy Walker's daughter. His wife died in 1813. His Aunt was married to Captain Ford, Esquire. He lived at 480 Woburn Street. Was the son-in-law of Captain Timothy Walker. Also brother to Joseph Jenkins, Jr.

At age 19 was on the list of men responsible for turn of service at Crown Point Expedition, dated 8 July, 1776. Joel and father, Joseph credited with 1 turn. At age 20, was a sergeant in Captain Jesse Luyman's Company, Colonel Josiah Witney's Regiment. Arrived at destination on 10 May 1777. Discharged 10 July 1777 at Point Judith (Narragansett, Rhode Island). Service: 2 month, 9 days at Rhode Island, including 3 days travel to point of destination (60 miles) and 5 days travel from point Judith to home. During the American Revolution, the British controlled Narragansett Bay and raided and burned the farms on Point Judith and the surrounding areas in the late 1770's under Captain Wallace.

He also served as a private in Captain Ford's Company, Colonel Eleazer Brook's Regiment of Guards. Enlisted on 5 Nov 1777. Served to 3 April, 1778. Served 4 months, 29 days at Fort No. 2 guarding Troops of Convention (Burgoyne's Troops taken at Saratoga). He reported on Furlough, December 1778. Was paid for services by Captain Ford on 22 May, 1778. Also enlisted 13 May, 1778 in Continental Army for 8 months from time of arrival at Peekskill, New York. Was paid 30 pounds in partial payment. Was a Private in Captain Edward Richardson's Company, Colonel Thomas Poor's Regiment. Discharged 18 February, 1779. Service 7 months, 23 days at North River, New York (contemporary name for the lower Hudson River), including 12 days travel to home (240 miles). Served at Watertown, New York, West Point and Kings Ferry.

Joel married **Elizabeth WALKER**, daughter of Capt Timothy WALKER and Eunice BREWSTER, on 13 Jun 1784 in Wilmington, Middlesex, MA, USA. Elizabeth was born on 15 Feb 1763 in Wilmington, Middlesex, MA, USA. She died on 3 May 1813 in Wilmington, Middlesex, MA, USA. She was buried in May 1813 in Wildwood Cemetery: Wilmington, Middlesex, MA, USA.

BIOGRAPHY: "Aunt Fern" was an actress. Did stage work in New

Fern Foster was the first wife of silent cowboy star Harry Carey, whom she co-starred with in his play "Two Women and that Man" on Broadway. The play, which opened at the Majestic Theatre on October 18, 1909.

Fern followed Harry into motion pictures, making her film debut in "His Day" (1912). Harry began his evolution into a star, appearing in films for director D. W. Griffith at Biograph, and in 1914, he cast Fern in two movies he wrote and directed for the Progressive Motion Picture Co., *The Master Cracksman* (1914) and *McVeagh of the South Seas* (1914).

Fern Foster retired from the movies after making the two pictures with her husband. Harry later divorced Fern and married his co-star in his well known "Cheyenne Harry" Westerns, Olive Golden (Olive Carey), in 1920.

According to Mom (Laura A. Foster - Irving), Fern's complexion was a little dark which made it difficult to film with the old black and white movie film technology of the day. Therefore, she never made it in films.

In correspondence from Harry Carey Jr. Fern and Harry were married for only six years (seems right; 1908-1914). Harry Jr. also said that an actor friend, Wendell Corey, performed in some summer stock performances with Fern Foster. Wendell said she was a very good actress. This indicates that after she left Harry Carey she continued acting, probably as a part time occupation.

Suspect that her first name is Alma, and that Fern is her middle name. Her burial record gives her name as Alma Fern Foster Harms.

There is a 1930 Census record for Chicago, IL which might be the Harms (Harry W. and Fern). That census records Fern's first marriage age being 23, which implies she married Harry Carey in 1908.

The Internet Movie Database (IMDb.com) includes data on Fern Foster and first husband Harry Carey

Fern married **Harry DeWitt CAREY** about 1908 in , , NY, USA. They had no children. The marriage ended in divorce. Harry was born on 16 Jan 1878 in Bronx, , NY, USA. He died on 21 Sep 1947 in Los Angeles, Los Angeles, CA, USA.



Notable individual because He was a prolific motion picture character actor.

Born in New York City to a Judge of Special Sessions who was also president of a sewing machine company. Grew up on City Island, New York. Attended Hamilton Military Academy and turned down an appointment to West Point to attend New York University law school.

After a boating accident which led to pneumonia, Carey wrote a play while recuperating and toured the country in it for three years, earning a great deal of money, all of which evaporated after his next play was a failure. But he married his co-star of that failure - Fern Foster. In 1911, his friend Henry B. Walthall introduced him to director D. W. Griffith, for whom Carey was to make many films.

Carey married twice, first to Fern Foster and the second time to actress Olive Fuller Golden (aka Olive Carey).

Carey grew into one of the most popular Western stars of the early motion picture, occasionally writing and directing films as well. In the '30s he moved slowly into character roles and was nominated for an Oscar for one of them, the President of the Senate in Mr. Smith Goes to Washington (1939). He died after a protracted bout with emphysema and cancer. John Ford dedicated his remake of 3 Godfathers (1948) "To Harry Carey--Bright Star Of The Early Western Sky." Harry was a great friend of John Wayne and is said to have taught John his swagger walk. Harry played in over 250 movies in his career.
